<b>Learning outcomes</b>	<p>Scientific and educational program</p> <p>The general educational aim of the “History of Societies, Institutions and Thought. From Medieval to Contemporary History” doctorate is uniform for all curricula, even though differing themes and perspectives are explored depending on the specific area of interest.</p> <p>The doctorate intends to train scholars able to identify ample scientific problems of historical or philosophical nature; plan and carry out studies organically connected to the chosen area of research;</p> <p>identify and make competent use of necessary sources or critically analyze data, texts, themes, concepts and methods; identify and make use of an international bibliography; organize and present the material they have gathered and compose a scientific text. 	<p>4 – History of Thought and Philosophies</p> <p>The training provided during the three-year program aims to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to produce scientific results worthy of presentation at conferences and/or publication in monographic form or in specialized journals;</li> <li>- to build up argumentative and communicative experience by way of frequent seminars and workshops;</li> <li>- to increase disposition for team work and interaction with other researchers.</li> </ul>
