Credits and exams	In Italian Universities, the minimum passing grade is 18/30. Exams with a final evaluation below 18/30 have not been passed successfully. The maximum grade is 30/30 (30/30 with honours). The credits corresponding to each



	academic activity is acquired by a student only when he/she passes an exam or another kind of learning evaluation. The Italian grading system is expressed in CFU. 1 CFU corresponds to 1 ECTS.
<b>HOUSING</b>	
Assistance for accommodation	It is quite easy to find a shared room once students arrive. We suggest students that they book a hostel or hotel for the first two weeks while looking for a permanent accommodation. The Welcome Office FVG ( <a href="http://www.welcomeoffice.fvg.it/">http://www.welcomeoffice.fvg.it/</a> ) and the Erasmus Students Network ( <a href="https://trieste.esn.it/">https://trieste.esn.it/</a> ) both offer some kind of assistance.
On-campus accommodation	<i>A limited number of rooms are available in student dormitories, and are reserved for students from non-EU Universities.</i>
<b>FINANCIAL MATTERS</b>	
Average expenses per month (in Euros): - accommodation - food - transportation - books - miscellaneous	Accommodation: starting from about 250 Euros for a place in a double room. Food: 200 Euros. Transportation: 40 Euros per month. Books: 100 Euros (most of the books can be borrowed at the university libraries) Internet: 20 Euros; Phone: 20 Euros; Utilities: 30 Euros
