HOUSING	
Assistance for accommodation	It is quite easy to find a shared room once students arrive. We suggest students that they book a hostel or hotel for the first two weeks while looking for a permanent accommodation. The Welcome Office FVG (http://www.welcomeoffice.fvg.it/) and the Erasmus Students Network (https://trieste.esn.it/ both offer some kind of assistance.
On-campus accommodation	A limited number of rooms are available in student dormitories, and are reserved for students from non-EU Universities.
FINANCIAL MATTERS	
Average expenses per month (in Euros):	Accommodation: starting from about 250 Euros for a place in a double room. Food: 200 Euros. Transportation: 40 Euros per month. Books: 100 Euros (most of the books can be borrowed at the university libraries) Internet: 20 Euros; Phone: 20 Euros; Utilities: 30 Euros
