

## **Logic-quantitative test for all first-year students** **8<sup>th</sup> September 2011 9 a.m. in Aula Magna Building H3**

All students are asked to take an entrance exam based on a multiple-choice logic quantitative knowledge questionnaire, which is designed to check the applicants' preparation. This test will take place on **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> of September at 9 a.m. in room Aula Magna, building H3. Not passing the test will not block matriculation, course attendance, nor access to exams.**

If students don't pass this test, additional support before attending classes, will be offered during the pre-courses in Mathematics, Principles of Economics\* and Accounting\*. These support courses are available for all first-year students of the Faculty of Economics. **Pre-courses take place from the 12<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> of September and all interested students are invited to attend them.**

Another logic-quantitative test will be offered in **September 2012**. Those students, who do not take or pass the test in September 2011, who however will have passed one or more first-year exam for a total amount of 12 Credits (Language and Computer Science exams are not included) until September 2012 are exempted from taking the test again.

**Whereas students, who will not have passed any of the listed tests (logic questionnaire or exams for 12 credits), may confirm second year registration, but are not allowed to take second-year examinations previous to satisfying one of the above-mentioned conditions.**

Students coming from other Faculties or Universities are bend to the same kind of assessment if they do not demonstrate to have passed a similar assessment at their previous University.

## **English Curricula**

In order to undertake an intensive and challenging academic course that is examined in English, if the students' first language is not English, it is essential that their English language skills are good enough. As a result, students may also be asked to meet a specific English language requirement or, if not, to take an English Test.

**Presentation of valid certifications is on the 7<sup>th</sup> of September at 9 a.m. in room B of the Faculty of Economics (Building D)** or, if not possible on that date, by appointment with the Faculty's Secretary Office at [segreco@econ.units.it](mailto:segreco@econ.units.it).

**English entrance test** for applicants not possessing a valid certification will take place on **the 7<sup>th</sup> of September at 10.00 in room B of the Faculty of Economics (Building D)**. Students not passing the English entrance test will be kindly advised not to enrol (if possible to pass to an Italian curriculum), in any case they will not be accepted to exam sessions before gaining the requested English language proficiency level.

The following list of English exams is a guideline used to establish the minimum level of proficiency. In order to support these students they will be allowed to attend English classes and English lab classes, offered by the Faculty as well for Italian Study Courses, in order to improve their knowledge.

Students possessing valid certifications, among those listed below, which may not be dated prior to 2009, are exempted from taking the English admission test. Applicants' English proficiency will be evaluated on an individual basis, therefore the guideline below is not exclusive and other exams may be considered.

## **International students from outside the EU**

International students coming from outside the EU wishing to attend Italian curricula courses, are asked to take an Italian Test on the 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2011 at 9.00 in room F (Building D). They are moreover asked to take the logic-quantitative knowledge questionnaire together with Italian students, either in Italian or in English, on the 8<sup>th</sup> of September, 2011 (see above for further information).

They also may contact the International Student Office to complete their application process.

We remind that International students from outside EU, who will attend the English curriculum course, may not sit for the Italian test on the 1<sup>st</sup> of September, 2011. Though they will have to demonstrate Italian knowledge before their final degree exam in the end of their third year.
