Key tasks

- analyze draft legislative texts in the areas attributed to her\him and summarize them in order to get feedback from the interested business lines on likely criticalities on which advocacy efforts will need to concentrate;
- draft the position papers of the Group based on the feedback received, including proposed amendments to the draft legislative texts;
- take part in events\conferences in order to monitor and report what institutional speakers state;
- provide timely information on the development of the legislative process to the relevant business lines in the areas attributed to him\her; update UniCredit positions according to such developments if needed;
- coordinate and prepare speaking engagements of the Group Top Management in cooperation with the Top Management Executive Staff and receiving feedback by the business areas from time to time involved;
- take responsibility for the day-to-day organisation of its activities including keeping track of all required contributions by trade\banking associations and institutional counterparts.

And of the key competencies

- academic path in law;
- an advanced-level command of English and proven skills in English writing;
- preferably a good understanding of the EU legislative process;
- ideally, a broad knowledge of banking law specifically in the capital markets or prudential area;
- ability to build relationships, work as part of a team, communicate effectively, exercise policy judgement, coordinate contributions from a range of different counterparts and think analytically.
